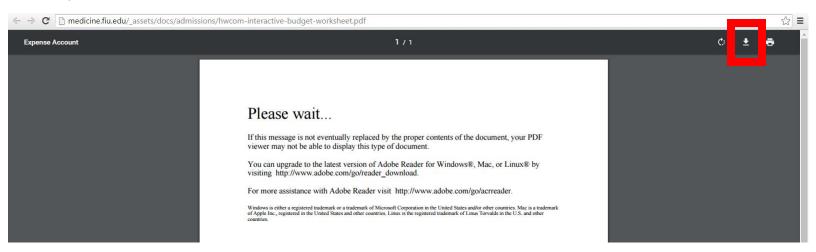
What is the MPAS Interactive Budget Worksheet?

The purpose of the Budget Worksheet is to assist you in budgeting for the upcoming academic year. It is a useful tool to help you in determining how much financial aid you should accept.

Supported Browsers

The worksheet works on the updated current versions of Chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer and Safari.

When using Chrome, Firefox and Safari, you will encounter the message below. To retrieve the Interactive Budget Worksheet, please download by clicking the button indicated in red below. This will prompt you to save the document on your device.



**If you're using a supported browser i.e. Chrome, but the tuition prices are not populating and you are unable to fill in the sheet, you may be using an extension that interferes with browser detection. Try disabling your browser extensions to resolve the problem.

For example, Chrome has its own PDF viewer but it does not work well with the interactive form and must be disabled. To Disable the Chrome PDF viewer please follow the directions below so that the form will open in Adobe viewer instead.

- 1) In the Chrome browser bar, enter the text: chrome://plugins
- 2) Find the Chrome PDF viewer and the Adobe Reader plug-in.
- 3) Ensure that the Chrome viewer is disabled and that Adobe Reader is enabled. See Adobe XI Acrobat Help for step-by-step instructions.

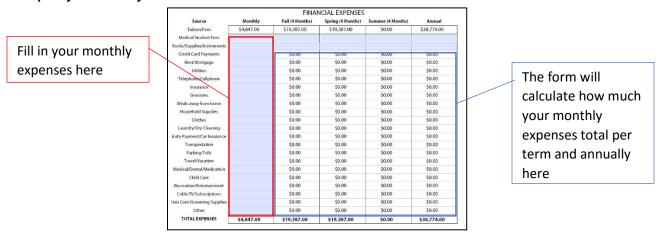

2.) You are now ready to start filling in the Budget Worksheet. Start in the Financial Resources section. The Financial Resources sections require manual input. The form will then total the amounts in each column as you fill in the form.

3.) Next fill in the Financial Expenses portion of the worksheet. For this section, input your expenses in the Monthly column and the form will calculate how much that equals per term and annually, as well as total the amounts in each column. Books and Supplies and MPAS Student Fees need to be inputted manually based on your actual expenses for these items.

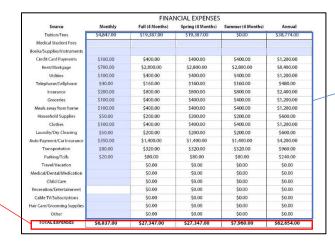

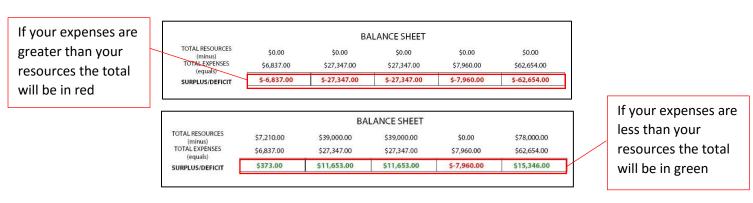

5.) Once both sections (Financial Resources and Financial Expenses) are completed, you can scroll down to the last section titled Balance Sheet and see what your Resources minus your Expenses equals to be able to determine if you have accepted enough Financial Aid or budgeted accordingly.
