Final Report Outline

Please include the following items within your final report. Note that portions of your report may be used in orienting future volunteers.

Service Experience

- -Description of your service work, your primary activities, and the skills needed for your job(s)
- -Service placement (or list of placements) in which you worked
- -Your role in each service placement, how often you were there, length of time, in what capacity.
- -Available resources -- materials and people

Impact of Experience

- How have you grown, what have your learned about yourself, what made an impact on you?
- How have you used your individual strengths?
- What were the highlights of your service work?

Recommendations

- -What to read or study before arrival
- -What to bring clothing, resources
- -Local Recreation opportunities, health services, shopping, etc.
- -Local culture and cross-cultural issues

Logistics

-Your living situation, any benefits / issues

Please include the following items:

- 1) A short article (one page at most) about one of your experiences while working in the community or at the local hospitals
- 2) 3-5 photos of you 'in action' at one of your service sites (in JPG format)
