POLICY STATEMENT

All student interviews must comply with FIU Media Policy 175.105, which mandates central coordination of all press conferences, press releases, and media inquiries that relate to or involve a unit of the university, except for those media inquiries that seek an opinion from any member of the university community in his or her individual capacity.

Students are required to consult with the HWCOM Office of Student Affairs prior to agreeing to or participating in media interviews related to the college or any of its programs.

Students are expressly prohibited from acting as an official representative or spokesperson for FIU or HWCOM. When granting interviews, students must identify opinions as their own and not representative of the views of FIU or HWCOM.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all medical students.

This policy covers the criteria for granting media interviews.
